GENDER AND RELATIONS

Gender refers to the gender of a person or an animal, like male and female.





TYPES OF GENDER

A noun that names a *male* person or animal is called as 'Masculine Gender'. **Eg.**: Boy, Ox, King etc.

A noun that names a *female* person or animal is called as 'Feminine Gender'. 2. Eg.: Girl, Cow, Queen etc.
