



Questions are sentences expressed in such a way as to gather information, which require an answer.



'Why' is trying to get the reason for his friend's shouting.



'Where' is trying to get the answer regarding the place of his lost wallet.



Whose dress is this?



How many students were present in the class yesterday?




Is your friend coming today?

In the above sentences, 'How many', 'Whose' and 'Is' are used to frame the questions.


Words that come in the beginning of the sentences and make the sentence a question are called **Question words**.

Eg.: What, Why, When, Where, Whose, Whom, How much, How many etc.
