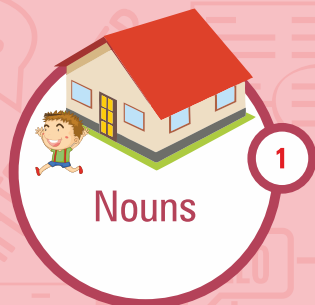

ADJECTIVES

Adjectives are words that modify Nouns or Pronouns.

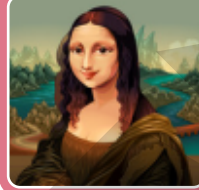
'Describing words' are called Adjectives.

Let's see some examples of Adjectives –

A **beautiful** deer was running for food.



The painting is **wonderful**.



I saw something **strange** outside the window.

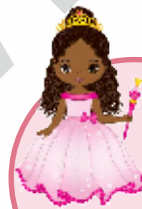

Position of Adjectives

Most Adjectives can go in three different places in a sentence:

1.

Before Nouns -
attributive position

I have read an **interesting** book.

2.

After Verbs -
predicative position
The knife is **sharp**.

3.

After Indefinite Pronouns -
Someone small in height
can come.

Types of Adjectives

Adjective of Quality

Tells the kind or quality of a noun or pronoun.

Eg: Black, White, Big, Small
We saw **black** and **white** cats.

Adjective of Quantity

Tells the quantity of a noun or a pronoun and answers - How much?

Eg: Much, Little, No
A **little** water is left in the jug.

Adjective of Number

Tells the number of a noun or pronoun and answers - How many?

Eg: Many, Few, One, Two
Many children are playing in the garden.

Demonstrative Adjective

Used to indicate / point out a noun or pronoun.

Eg: This, That, These, Those
She wants **those** flowers.

Interrogative Adjective

Used to ask questions about nouns.

Eg: What, Which, Where, Whose
Whose house is that?

Possessive Adjective

Used to indicate possession.

Eg: My, Our, Your, His, Her, Its, Their, etc.
My house is big.

Distributive Adjective

Used to refer to individual nouns within the whole amount.

Eg: Each, Every, Either, Neither
Taxes have to be paid by **every** employed citizen.

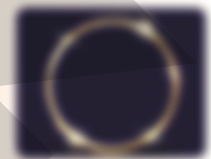
