CONDITIONAL SENTENCES

CONDITIONALS

You will pass your exams if you study hard.



If you study hard, you will pass your exams.

Conditionals describe the result of a certain condition. Different English verb tenses are used to describe different conditions. The word 'condition' means a 'situation'. If a condition is true, then a particular result happens.

In the above dialogues, the **if clause** tells you the condition (**If** you study hard) and the **main clause** tells you the result (you will pass your exams). The order of the clauses does not change the meaning.

DO YOU KNOW 7

What is a Clause?

A clause is a group of words that contains a subject and a verb.

Sometimes it makes a sentence by itself and sometimes it forms a part of a sentence.

There are two categories of clauses:


Independent or Main Clause

A clause that stands on its own.

Dependent or Subordinate Clause

A clause that needs to be joined with an independent clause.
